

# Have to free Indian edu from Sangh, says CPM

Yechury kicks off demo seeking Guv Arif's sacking

The bugle for Lok Sabha election 2024 has been sounded by the CPI(M) on Tuesday from the elegant square in front of Thiruvananthapuram Raj Bhavan. Sitarum Yechury, the CPI(M) All India General Secretary flew down to the capital city to inaugurate the party's demonstration demanding the sacking of Governor Arif Mohammed Khan whom the party commissar described as the stooge of the Sangh Parivar.

"This mammoth rally is the ultimatum to the Sangh Parivar and Prime Minister Narendra Modi who are out to infiltrate into the higher education centers of India to influence the minds of the youngsters with reactionary curriculum. The

Sangh Parivar elements have taken control of Jawaharlal Nehru University, Jamia Milia Islamia, Aligarh Muslim University, Central Universities across the country which were centers of excellence till 2014. We have to get these institutions liberated from the shackles of the Saffron brigade," said Yechury in his battle cry.

The CPI(M)'s glamour boy asked the people not to believe even a single word spoken by Prime Minister Modi. "He is repeating what Adolf Hitler did in Germany before the Second World War. Hitler created a wrong notion among the Germans that they were the blessed people with high intelligence and asked them to finish off other people. The Germans believed him and paid a high price for their thoughtlessness," declared the CPI(M) boss.

The demonstration and laying in siege to Raj Bhavan was held in the backdrop of the deteriorated ties between Arif Mohammed Khan and the



CPI(M). The LDF Government led by Pinarayi Vijayan has clipped the wings of Governor Khan by ousting him from the post of Chancellors in the universities in the State. Yechury declared that there was nothing surprising in the ouster of the Governor from the post of Chancellor. "Arif Mohammed Khan is holding the Chancellor's post because of the goodwill of the CPI(M). There is no doubt that he should go," declared Yechury.

All constituent units of the LDF were in attendance to hear and applaud the speech delivered by Yechury. "All of you should bear in mind that India is not one country as

claimed by Modi. The Prime Minister does not know about India and that is why he goes around the world claiming credit for everything," said Yechury.

Though the CPI(M) had claimed that more than a lakh people would take part in the demonstration, police sources said that there were 25,000 people. In a show of solidarity with the party who wants to oust the Governor, thousands of workers from Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Programme joined the demonstration. They were transported to Raj Bhavan from far away places like Kannur and Kasaragod.

# Cong gives list of 40 star campaigners for Gujarat

The Congress on Tuesday released a list of 40 star campaigners, which includes former party presidents Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi and party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra.

Newly elected Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel are among the other prominent names on the list. The list also includes former deputy chief minister of Rajasthan Sachin Pilot who is not on very good terms with Gehlot who is currently the monitoring the assembly elections of Gujarat due in first week of December.

Rahul Gandhi, who's name also figured as star campaigners in the just concluded polls in Himachal Pradesh, did not campaign there but sources in the party said the Lok Sabha MP is scheduled to conduct a couple of road shows in the poll bound Gujarat which also hap-



pens to be the home state of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Former chief ministers of Madhya Pradesh, Digvijaya Singh and Kamal Nath, are also scheduled to campaign in Gujarat where state leaders have shouldered most of the campaign efforts so far. Kanhaiya Kumar, who joined the Congress last year, will also campaign for the party.

The list of star campaigners also features around 11 leaders from the state, includ-

ing Gujarat Pradesh Congress Committee (GPCC) president Jagdish Thakor and Leader of Opposition Sukhrum Rathva. One of the names missing from the list of star campaigners is that of Shashi Tharoor who last visited Gujarat while contesting the polls for the post of party president last month. Election to the 182 Assembly seats in Gujarat will be held in two phases, on December 1 and 5, while the results will be out on December 8.

# Chronically depressed girl student kills self in AMU hostel

A Class 12 student of Aligarh Muslim University's Abdullah Girls College committed suicide by hanging herself in her room in the girls' hostel on Monday. Investigation revealed that the student was depressed for the past several years and was undergoing treatment. Tired of this disease, she took her life.

The girl's family had also reached here from Bijnor Najibabad late in the evening, and were not ready to allow the police to get the post-mortem of the girl conducted.

Four other girl students also stay in the same room with her. According to the events, a program was organized in the college campus in which she was to participate. But she wrote an application for the warden/class teacher citing ill health and sought permission to go to JN Medical College.

On getting permission, she went back to the room and committed suicide. Her fellow students found her hanging when they returned.

# Shraddha redux: UP girl's chopped body found in well

Close on the heels of a sensational killing of a girl in the national Capital, a similar murder took place in Azamgarh where the body of the victim was recovered in several pieces on Tuesday morning. After brutally killing the girl and chopping her body into pieces, the killer dumped the body into a well.

The local police rushed to the spot along with senior officers and took out the body pieces and sent them for autopsy. Further investigations are being made to identify the victim and to arrest the killer.

The incident came to light when the people of the village came out of the village for their farming work. During this,



someone looked into a well at the roadside and saw the mutilated body of a young girl lying in it. The villagers informed the police about the incident. On getting information, the police rushed to the spot.

According to reports, some villagers in Gauri Ka

Pura of Paschimpatti village in Azamgarh district reached the well on Tuesday morning and were shocked to see some pieces of a body inside the well. They immediately called the police who took out all the pieces and later suspected it to be a woman, probably in their

mid-twenties. The girl's head, arms and legs were chopped off. There were no clothes on the body of the deceased and it appeared that she was gang-raped before being killed. A watch was also found in one of the hands of the girl. Station House Officer Yogendra Bahadur Singh said it appeared that the victim was killed two days ago but they were waiting for a post-mortem report besides trying to ascertain the identity of the victim.

Meanwhile, a woman and her daughter were found murdered in their home in Ghazipur district. Both were probably killed some time on Sunday night and the victims were found dead on Monday morning.

# Give dues or quit: Didi to Centre

After many months Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday directly targeted Prime Minister Narendra Modi for not releasing funds to her State and wondered whether she would have to catch his feet to get the MNREGA and other funds released. Speaking in a meeting at Jhargram the Chief Minister said "despite repeated requests to the Prime Minister, funds legally due to the State have not been released ... these are not personal funds ... they do not come from anyone's zamindari (landed estate) ... they are taxpayers' money and rightfully belong to the people of Bengal who are being deprived of what is legally theirs."

She said that those who were at the helm in the Centre should "either release the funds

or step down from power... I have several times written to them and requested them for funds ... now will I have to catch their feet to get these funds released ... they will not do any kindness to us by release the funds ... this is our right to get what is rightfully ours."

Banerjee has of late --- particularly after the stepped up actions of ED and CBI in the State --- refrained from making adverse remarks against the Prime Minister. Instead she has often found praising him while holding Home Minister Amit Shah for conspiring against Bengal and the Trinamool

Congress. Saying that either the Centre should release the money or they should stop collecting Goods and Services Tax. "What is the point in giving GST if we do not get our share from it ... either they should release the funds or they should stop claiming GST," Banerjee said.

Banerjee was visiting the tribal-dominated Jhargram district for the first time after her ministerial colleague Akhil Giri kicked up a storm a few days ago by making disparaging remarks against President Droupadi Murmu for which the Chief Minister had to

make a public apology. Taking a swipe at the Centre for withholding hundred-days funds for several months --- a development that had irked lakhs of people in the villages ahead of next year's panchayat elections --- Banerjee said "the poor people are suffering and the government has held back the MNREGA funds ... why should they deprive the poor people of their basic needs ... what is their fault," wondering whether there was an erosion in the democratic values in the country. "Are we living in a democracy? ... Has India become a one-party rule?" she asked.
